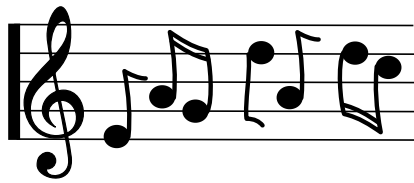

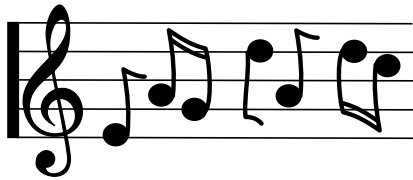

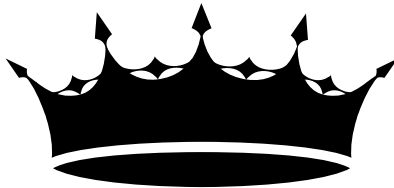


Good King Wenceslas

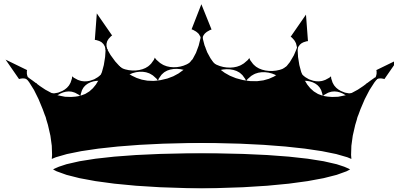
